Page 1 of 1 Requires schools to use a 10-point grading scale to assign grades used in the calculation of the minimum grade point average required for initial award eligibility

Proposed legislation requires all public and approved nonpublic schools to use a 10-point grading scale for the purpose of assigning grades used in the calculation of the minimum grade point average for Taylor Opportunity Program for Students (TOPS) award qualification, regardless of whether the school uses a different grading scale for other purposes.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

Nonpublic schools may experience an increase in costs to either adopt a new grading scale or convert their existing grading scale to meet the requirements of proposed legislation, but such an impact is not anticipated to be significant.
