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Provides for review of local redistricting plans

Current law requires the parish governing authority of each parish to establish precincts, define the territorial limits and prescribe the boundaries of each precinct; authorizes the parish governing authority to change established precincts. Proposed law requires that prior to the adoption of an ordinance to establish, divide, or merge precincts, the local governing authority must submit the proposed precincts to the clerk of court and registrar of voters to confirm the ability to conduct an election utilizing the proposed boundaries.

Proposed law further provides that prior to the adoption of any local redistricting or reapportionment plan, a local governing authority must submit the proposed plan to the parish registrar of voters and clerk of court for review and to confirm the ability to conduct an election utilizing the proposed plan.
