Present law defines "drug paraphernalia" and exempts rapid fentanyl test strips or any testing equipment or devices solely used, intended for use, or designed to determine whether a substance contains fentanyl or its analogues from the definition.

Proposed law expands the definition to include any testing equipment or devices solely used, intended for use, or designed to determine whether a substance contains any controlled substance or chemical compound that can cause physical harm or death.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
