1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "reenact" delete the remainder of the line and insert:

3 "the introductory paragraph of R.S. 14:130.1(A) and 134(A) and to enact R.S.
4 14:130.1(A)(6) and (B)(6) and (7), relative to criminal"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, line 5, after "enforcement" insert "and other official governmental acts"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 8, after "Section 1." delete the remainder of the line and insert:

9 "The introductory paragraph of R.S. 14:130.1(A) and 134(A) are hereby amended and
10 reenacted and R.S. 14:130.1(A)(6) and (B)(6) and (7) are"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 1, line 9, delete "is"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 1, delete lines 11 through 14 and insert:

15 "A. The crime of obstruction of justice is any of the following acts when
16 committed with the knowledge that ~~such~~ **the** act has, reasonably may, or will affect
17 an actual or potential present, past, or future criminal proceeding ~~as described in this~~
18 **Section: , civil immigration proceeding, or official act of an agent or employee**
19 **of a governmental entity:**"

20 AMENDMENT NO. 6

21 On page 1, after line 17, insert:

22 "B. Whoever commits the crime of obstruction of justice shall be subject to
23 the following penalties:

24 * * *

25 **(6) When the obstruction of justice involves a civil immigration**
26 **proceeding, the offender shall be fined not more than five thousand dollars,**
27 **imprisoned for not more than one year, or both.**

28 **(7) When the obstruction of justice involves an official act of an agent or**
29 **employee of a governmental entity, the offender shall be fined not more than**
30 **one thousand dollars, imprisoned for not more than six months, or both.**
