Abstract: Provides an exception for certain reemployed retirees in the La. State Employees' Retirement System (LASERS) from any increase, suspension, or reduction of benefits as a result of reemployment.

Present law requires a reemployed retiree of LASERS to meet the following requirements to be exempt from any benefit increase, suspension, or reduction during reemployment:

- (1) 30 years of creditable service.
- (2) Retired for one year.
- (3) Is eligible to receive his full retirement benefit.
- (4) Appointed by the governor to fill an unclassified civil service position.

Proposed law reduces the service credit requirement to 25 years of service.

Proposed law requires that any cost of proposed law be funded with additional employer contributions in compliance with the present constitution (Art. X, Sec. 29(F)).
