16	Natchitoches, Assumption, Cameron, Terrebonne, Beauregard, St. Landry, or St.
17	Tammany, the governing authority of any municipality within one of said parishes,

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 33:4754) provides that the governing authority of certain enumerated parishes and municipalities may adopt ordinances, rules, and regulations in order to secure or cause to be secured any building or other structure situated within the respective parish or municipality, which endangers the public welfare or safety.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and includes the city of Lafayette and Lafayette Parish to the parishes and municipalities authorized to adopt ordinances, rules and regulations related to the removal, securing, condemnation, and demolition of dilapidated and dangerous structures.

Effective August 1, 2025.
