R.S. 22:881.1 is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 22:1276 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 11 12 §881.1. Discounts; disclosure requirements; renewals and prior premiums; 13 homeowners' and motor vehicle policies 14 A. Every insurer that writes homeowners' or private passenger motor vehicle 15 insurance policies in this state shall, in writing that is not less than twelve-point font, 16 disclose all discounts that the insurer offers that may reduce the homeowners' or motor vehicle insurance premium of a policyholder or prospective policyholder. 17 Insurers shall ensure that the disclosure is delivered by electronic means as defined 18 19 in R.S. 22:2461 or submit the disclosure within the written materials of a new policy 20 delivered to the policyholder and at each subsequent renewal. For purposes of this 21 Section, "discounts" means premium credits advertised by an insurer to 22 policyholders who meet certain criteria defined by the insurer. An insurer's failure 23 to comply with this Section does not create a cause of action. 24 B. If an insurer issues a renewal policy of homeowners' or private 25 passenger motor vehicle insurance in this state, the insurer shall provide the 26 premium for the policy last issued by the insurer with the respective renewal 27 policy, and shall ensure the prior premium is prominently displayed in close

B. C. This Section shall does not apply to excess and surplus lines.
