EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. The Gaming Control Board currently has established procedures for investigating, licensing, and enforcing all aspects of gaming operations and activities. The LFO believes the board is able to absorb any marginal impact to workload within its current budget.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

To the extent a 6th LSRC-licensed pari-mutuel or off-track wagering facility operating video draw poker devices opens in Jefferson Parish, Statutory Dedicated revenues are anticipated to increase to both the Video Draw Poker Device Purse Supplement Fund and the Video Draw Poker Device Fund. Over the past three years, approximately 84% of the revenues from the Video Draw Poker Device Fund have been allocated to local governments. The overall revenue impact of a 6th facility is uncertain, as it could expand the gaming market, cannibalize a portion of the business at the five existing facilities, or some combination of both.
