BOARDS/COMMISSIONS: Amends the appointing process for certain occupational licensing boards, committees, and authorities

7 all of whom shall be residents of this state and holders of valid licenses. Each
8 appointment shall be made ~~from~~ by the governor, who may consider a list of three
9 or more names submitted to the governor by the Society of Louisiana Certified
10 Public Accountants or its successor.

15 (2) One member shall be appointed from each public service commission
16 district in the following manner:

17 (a) The Louisiana State Association of Journeymen Barbers, Hair Dressers,
18 Cosmetologists, and Proprietors shall submit to the governor a list of three names for
19 each vacancy that may exist on the board, one of whom shall be a member of a racial
20 minority and a member of the nominating organization.

21 (b) When more than one vacancy exists at the same time, the name of any
22 person may not appear on more than one list.

23 (c) Upon receipt of the lists, the governor ~~shall~~ may consider the list and
24 select and appoint one member.

28 B.(1) The governor shall appoint members to the board and may consider the
29 appointments from among professional engineer nominees recommended by the

1 Louisiana Engineering Society or its duly recognized successor and from among
2 professional land surveyor nominees recommended by the Louisiana Society of
3 Professional Surveyors or its duly recognized successor. All such nominees shall
4 have the qualifications required by R.S. 37:684.

13 §753. Louisiana State Board of Dentistry; appointment of members; term of office;
14 vacancies; nominating meetings; quorum; domicile

16 C. Each member of the board shall be appointed by the governor as follows:

17 (1)(a) One dentist shall be appointed from each board district, except that
18 two dentists shall be appointed from District Five and designated as representatives
19 "A" and "B". Each appointment from an electoral district ~~shall~~ may be made from
20 a list of three names of nominees for the respective district submitted to the governor
21 by the board. The district nominees shall be selected from the roster of licensed
22 dentists in the districts at a nominating meeting convened in accordance with the
23 provisions of Subsection F of this Section. The voting domicile of each nominee for
24 appointment and not his office address shall determine his district for purposes of
25 holding office in accordance with the provisions of this Paragraph. The nominating
26 meeting shall be held at least ninety days prior to the vacancy occurring by reason
27 of an expiring term or within thirty days after a vacancy occurring by reason of
28 death, resignation, or for any other reason.

1 offices. The submission of such information on the ballot shall serve as confirmation
 2 that the voter has discussed the nomination with the nominees and they have agreed
 3 to serve if nominated and appointed by the governor. The ballot shall be mailed out
 4 by the board secretary at least ninety days prior to any vacancy occurring by reason
 5 of an expiring term or within thirty days after a vacancy occurring by reason of
 6 death, resignation, or for any other reason. After the board secretary has tabulated
 7 all ballots received at the board offices, the names of the three nominees receiving

14 B.(1) The board shall be composed of eight registered nurses appointed by
 15 the governor ~~from~~ who may consider a list of names submitted by the Louisiana
 16 State Nurses Association, one certified registered nurse anesthetist appointed by the
 17 governor ~~from~~ who may consider a list of names submitted by the Louisiana
 18 Association of Nurse Anesthetists, Ltd., and two representatives of the consumers
 19 of Louisiana from the state at-large appointed by the governor, neither of whom shall
 20 be a nurse. Each board member shall possess all of the applicable qualifications
 21 provided in R.S. 37:916.

25 C. The appointment of members of the board shall be made ~~from~~ by the
 26 governor, who may consider a list, containing twice the number of eligibles to be
 27 appointed, submitted to the governor by the Louisiana State Medical Society where
 28 the appointee shall be a licensed physician, by the Louisiana Federation of Licensed
 29 Practical Nurses, Inc., for one of the practical nurses, by the Licensed Practical

1 Nurses of Louisiana, Inc., for one of the practical nurses, by the Louisiana Nursing
2 Home Association, for one practical nurse, by the Louisiana Hospital Association,
3 for one practical nurse, or by the Louisiana State Nurses Association where the
4 appointee shall be a registered nurse. The consumer member may apply directly to
5 the office of the governor. The governor shall ensure that his appointments
6 demonstrate race, gender, ethnic, and geographical diversity.

8 §1104. Louisiana Licensed Professional Counselors Board of Examiners

9 A. There is hereby created in the Louisiana Department of Health the
10 Louisiana Licensed Professional Counselors Board of Examiners, hereafter referred
11 to as the "board", consisting of eleven members who shall be residents of the state
12 of Louisiana. Each term shall be for four years. Seven appointments to the board,
13 including one consumer from the public at large, shall be made by the governor ~~from~~
14 who may consider a list of qualified candidates submitted by the executive board of
15 the Louisiana Counseling Association. The consumer member may also apply
16 directly to the office of the governor. Four appointments to the board shall be made
17 by the governor ~~from~~ who may consider a list of qualified candidates submitted by
18 the executive board of the Louisiana Association for Marriage and Family Therapy.
19 Each appointment by the governor shall be submitted to the Senate for confirmation.
20 The governor shall ensure that his appointments demonstrate race, gender, ethnic,
21 and geographical diversity.

24 (2)(a) The board shall establish a Marriage and Family Therapy Advisory
25 Committee, which shall consist of the four licensed marriage and family therapist
26 board members appointed by the governor ~~from~~ who may consider a list of names
27 submitted by the executive board of the Louisiana Association for Marriage and
28 Family Therapy.

1 C. No board member shall serve more than two full consecutive terms. Any
 2 board member may be removed by the governor or majority vote of the board, after
 3 notice and hearing, for incompetence, neglect of duty, malfeasance in office, or
 4 moral turpitude. Any vacancy occurring in board membership for the three licensed
 5 professional counselors, three counselor educators, or one member of the public at
 6 large, other than by expiration of term, shall be appointed for the remainder of the
 7 unexpired term by the governor within thirty days ~~from~~ who may consider a list of
 8 qualified candidates supplied by the executive board of the Louisiana Counseling
 9 Association. Any vacancy occurring in board membership for the four licensed
 10 marriage and family therapists, other than by expiration of term, shall be appointed
 11 for the remainder of the unexpired term by the governor within thirty days ~~from~~ who
 12 may consider a list of qualified candidates supplied by the executive board of the
 13 Louisiana Association for Marriage and Family Therapy.

18 B. The board shall consist of ten voting members, all appointed by the
 19 governor and subject to Senate confirmation as follows:

20 (1) Two members who may be selected from a list of names submitted by
 21 the Louisiana State Medical Society. One of the members so appointed shall practice
 22 in a parish or municipality with a population of less than twenty thousand people.

23 (2) One member who may be selected from a list of names submitted by the
 24 Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center at New Orleans. At least every
 25 other member ~~appointed~~ who may be considered from a list provided for in this
 26 Paragraph shall be a minority appointee. Nothing in this Paragraph shall preclude
 27 consecutive minority appointments from lists provided for in this Paragraph.

28 (3) One member who may be selected from a list of names submitted by the
 29 Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center at Shreveport. At least every

1 other member ~~appointed~~ who may be considered from a list provided for in this
2 Paragraph shall be a minority appointee. Nothing in this Paragraph shall preclude
3 consecutive minority appointments from lists provided for in this Paragraph.

4 (4) One member who may be selected from a list of names submitted by the
5 Tulane Medical School.

6 (5) Two members who may be selected from a list submitted by the
7 Louisiana Medical Association.

8 (6) One member who may be selected from a list submitted by the Louisiana
9 Academy of Family Practice Physicians.

10 (7) One member who may be selected from a list submitted by the Louisiana
11 Hospital Association. At least every other member appointed from a list provided for
12 in this Paragraph shall be a minority appointee. Nothing in this Paragraph shall
13 preclude consecutive minority appointments from lists provided for in this
14 Paragraph.

20 (2) Three members of the committee shall be licensed physician assistants.

21 The physician assistant members of the advisory committee shall be appointed by
22 the governor ~~from~~ who may consider a list of names submitted by the Louisiana
23 Academy of Physician Assistants. At least one of the members of the advisory
24 committee shall be a physician assistant practicing in a parish or municipality with
25 a population of less than twenty thousand people.

27 (4) There shall be two members of the advisory committee who shall be
28 licensed supervising physicians who are appointed by the governor ~~from~~ who may

1 consider a list of names submitted by the Louisiana State Board of Medical
2 Examiners.

4 §1314. Clinical Laboratory Personnel Committee; creation; membership;
5 qualification; appointment; term; vacancy; officers; meetings; reimbursement

7 C.(1) The governor shall appoint ten members of the committee, subject to
8 Senate confirmation, as follows:

10 (e) One clinical laboratory scientist-specialist appointed ~~from~~ by the
11 governor, who may consider a list of four names compiled by the submission of two
12 names from each of the following two organizations:

14 (f) One clinical laboratory scientist-generalist who is in a supervisory or
15 administrative capacity appointed ~~from~~ by the governor, who may consider a list of
16 three names submitted by the Louisiana Hospital Association.

17 (g) One cytotechnologist appointed ~~from~~ by the governor, who may consider
18 a list of three names submitted by the Clinical Laboratory Personnel Association.

19 (h) One laboratory assistant who shall be a member of the American
20 Association of Bioanalysts appointed ~~from~~ by the governor, who may consider a list
21 of three names submitted by the Louisiana Hospital Association.

22 (i) One individual who is an administrator of a Louisiana community and
23 technical college appointed ~~from~~ by the governor, who may consider a list of names
24 submitted by the Louisiana Community and Technical College System.

25 (j) One individual who is an educator in a clinical laboratory science program
26 from a two or four year program appointed ~~from~~ by the governor, who may consider
27 a list of names submitted by the Board of Regents.

6 B.~~(1)~~ The committee shall be composed of a total of seven persons,
7 including four persons who hold an active license to engage in the practice of
8 perfusion in this state and are appointed by the governor ~~from~~ who may consider a
9 list of names submitted by the Louisiana Perfusion Society, or from the general
10 perfusion community should the Louisiana Perfusion Society disband; two
11 physicians who are actively engaged in the practice of cardiothoracic surgery,
12 appointed by the governor ~~from~~ who may consider a list of names submitted by the
13 Louisiana Society of Thoracic Surgeons; and one representative from a hospital with
14 an active open heart program, appointed by the governor ~~from~~ who may consider a
15 list of names submitted by the Louisiana Hospital Association. The initial
16 perfusionist appointees who would otherwise be required to be licensed perfusionists
17 shall instead be individuals who have been practicing perfusion for at least five years
18 and who are eligible pursuant to this Part for licensure as a perfusionist.

27 §1361. State Plumbing Board; appointments; qualifications; legislative intent;
28 authority

1 B. The State Plumbing Board is created. The board, which shall be
2 appointed by the governor, shall consist of one registered mechanical engineer who
3 is also licensed by the State Plumbing Board, one plumbing inspector who is also
4 licensed by the State Plumbing Board, three master plumbers, three journeyman
5 plumbers, one residential plumber limited, and two members of the public. Each
6 appointment shall be made in the following manner:

7 (1) The registered mechanical engineer ~~shall~~ may be from a list of three
8 names submitted by the Louisiana Department of Health.

9 (2) The plumbing inspector ~~shall~~ may be from a list of three names submitted
10 by the Louisiana State Uniform Construction Code Council.

11 (3) Master plumbers ~~shall~~ may be from a list of nine names submitted by the
12 Louisiana Association of Plumbing, Heating and Cooling Contractors or its
13 successors.

14 (4) Journeymen plumbers ~~shall~~ may be from a list of nine names submitted

20 B. The board shall be composed of one member from each congressional
21 district and one at-large member appointed by the governor ~~from~~ who may consider
22 a list of names submitted by the board of directors of the Louisiana Chapter of the
23 American Society of Home Inspectors, the Louisiana Realtors Association, and the
24 Louisiana Home Builders Association. Each member of the board shall be a United
25 States citizen and a resident of the state, and shall have been actively engaged in the
26 home inspection business on a full-time basis for three years preceding the
27 appointment. The initial board members shall be required to obtain a license in

1 Four members shall be appointed ~~from~~ by the governor, who may consider a list of
2 eight names submitted by the Associated Builders and Contractors of Louisiana.

3 (3) At least one member shall have had the greater part of his experience as
4 a licensed contractor in the field of mechanical construction, and shall may be
5 appointed ~~from~~ by the governor, who may consider a list of three names submitted
6 by the Mechanical Contractors Association of Louisiana.

7 (4) At least one member shall have had the greater part of his experience as
8 a licensed contractor in the field of electrical construction, and shall be appointed
9 ~~from~~ by the governor, who may consider a list of three names submitted by the
10 Louisiana Council of the National Electrical Contractors Association.

12 (7) At least one member shall have had the greater experience as a licensed
13 contractor in the field of oil field construction, and shall be appointed ~~from~~ by the
14 governor, who may consider a list of three names submitted by the Louisiana Oilfield
15 Contractors Association.

20 (2) The governor shall appoint members for terms of five years. Each
21 appointment by the governor shall be subject to Senate confirmation. A board
22 member shall not be eligible to succeed himself. ~~All psychologist~~ Psychologist
23 appointments shall be ~~from~~ appointed by the governor, who may consider a list
24 provided by the Louisiana Psychological Association. The list shall report the results
25 of an election in which persons qualified for board membership may nominate
26 themselves and in which licensed members of the Louisiana Psychological
27 Association and other persons licensed in accordance with the provisions of this
28 Chapter are entitled to one vote for each vacancy on the board. The consumer

1 member may apply directly to the office of the governor. The governor shall ensure

6 B. The board shall consist of eight members who shall be appointed by the
7 governor as follows:

9 (2) One member shall be a physical therapist who possesses an unrestricted
10 license to practice physical therapy and has been practicing in the state for no less
11 than three years and shall be appointed ~~from~~ by the governor, who may consider a
12 list of names submitted by the Louisiana Hospital Association.

13 (3) Two members shall be physical therapists who possess an unrestricted
14 license to practice physical therapy and have been practicing in the state for no less
15 than three years and shall be appointed ~~from~~ by the governor, who may consider a
16 list of names submitted by the Louisiana Physical Therapy Association.

17 * * *

18 (5) One member shall be a physician who possesses an unrestricted license
19 to practice medicine in the state and who specializes in the practice of orthopedic
20 surgery or the practice of physiatry and shall be appointed ~~from~~ by the governor,
21 who may consider a list of names submitted by the Louisiana State Medical Society.

23 §2455. Louisiana Board for Hearing Aid Dealers; composition; districts

25 B.(1) The board shall be composed of nine members. Seven members shall
26 be hearing aid dealers, the eighth member shall be the state health officer or his
27 representative, and the ninth member shall be fifty years of age or over and shall
28 serve as a representative of the hearing aid consumers of Louisiana. The seven
29 hearing aid dealers shall be appointed in the following manner. The Louisiana

1 Society of Hearing Aid Specialists, chartered by the state, shall submit to the
2 governor names of not less than fourteen qualified hearing aid dealers, who shall be
3 actively engaged in the selling and fitting of hearing aids. The governor may
4 consider this list when making appointments and shall ensure that his appointments
5 demonstrate race, gender, ethnic, and geographical diversity.

7 (4) ~~From~~ With consideration of this list the governor shall appoint seven
8 members of the board, two from District I, and one from each of the other five
9 districts. Of the seven hearing aid dealer members of the board, one shall be
10 appointed to serve a term of four years, two shall be appointed to serve for a term of
11 three years, two shall be appointed to serve for a term of two years, and two shall be
12 appointed to serve for a term of one year. Each member so appointed shall serve for
13 the term of his appointment, and thereafter until his successor has been appointed by
14 the governor. Each member shall be appointed for a term of four years. In the event
15 of a vacancy on the board, the governor shall appoint a new hearing aid dealer board
16 member to serve out the unexpired term. The members of the board shall annually
17 designate one such member to serve as chairman and another member to serve as
18 secretary-treasurer. No hearing aid dealer member of the board may be reappointed
19 to the board until at least one year after the expiration of his second term of office.

21 §2503. Board of Examiners of Nursing Facility Administrators

24 (3)(a) Three additional members shall be appointed by the governor ~~from~~
25 who may consider a list of names submitted to him by the board of directors of the
26 Louisiana Nursing Home Association, Inc. or its successor. The association shall
27 submit three names for each vacant position. Each appointment by the governor

1 shall be submitted to the Senate for confirmation. The three members appointed by
2 the governor shall serve three-year terms each.

4 §2654. Board of examiners; creation; membership; appointment; terms; chair;
5 quorum; domicile

7 C. Appointment to the board shall be made without regard to race or
8 ethnicity, age, religion, national origin, sex, or disability of the appointee. The board
9 shall within not less than thirty days prior to the expiration of each term of office,
10 submit to the governor a list of the names of interested and qualified individuals for
11 each respective category of board member identified through notice to all licensed
12 speech-language pathologists and audiologists in this state, from which the governor
13 ~~shall~~ may consider to make his appointment to fill the office for the next succeeding
14 term.

16 of the term, shall be filled by the governor for the unexpired portion of the term ~~from~~

21 A. There is hereby created a Louisiana State Board of Social Work
22 Examiners within the Louisiana Department of Health. The board shall be subject
23 to the provisions of R.S. 36:803. It shall consist of seven members to include six
24 social workers and one consumer member. The members shall be appointed by the
25 governor, subject to Senate confirmation. All appointees shall be selected ~~from~~ by
26 the governor, who may consider one list compiled by all statewide social work
27 membership organizations that have written bylaws and meet all state and federal
28 laws, and the Louisiana Chapter of the National Association of Social Workers shall
29 be responsible for the coordination of this process. The consumer member may apply

1 directly to the office of the governor. The governor shall ensure that his
2 appointments demonstrate race, gender, ethnic, and geographical diversity. All
3 appointees shall serve no more than two consecutive full terms. The completion of
4 an unexpired portion of a full term shall not constitute a full term for purposes of this
5 Section. The board shall consist of the following members:

7 §3061. Board of Electrolysis Examiners

8 A.(1)(a) The State Board of Electrolysis Examiners shall be composed of six
9 members, all to be appointed by the governor to serve at his pleasure.

10 (b) Four members shall be licensed electrologists who have been engaged
11 in the practice of electrology for at least five years prior to their appointment and
12 shall be appointed ~~from~~ by the governor, who may consider a list of names as
13 follows:

14 (i) Two shall be appointed ~~from~~ by the governor, who may consider a list of
15 four names submitted by the Louisiana Electrologist Association.

16 (ii) Two shall be appointed ~~from~~ by the governor, who may consider a list
17 of four names submitted by the Regional Electrologists Association of Louisiana.

18 (c) One member shall be appointed ~~from~~ by the governor, who may consider
19 a list of three physicians licensed to practice medicine in this state recommended by
20 the Louisiana State Medical Society, subject to the provisions of Subparagraph (2)(b)
21 of this Subsection.

23 (2)(a) If the governor determines that the nominees of the Louisiana
24 Electrologist Association, the Regional Electrologists Association of Louisiana, or
25 of the Louisiana State Medical Society are not suitable, he may decline to appoint

27 nominate an additional list of persons.
