Abstract: Prohibits the use of foreign funds to conduct elections or election campaigns, subject to criminal penalties.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the use of funds, goods, or services donated by a foreign government or nongovernmental source to conduct elections.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the use of funds, goods, or services donated by a foreign government, foreign entity, or noncitizen to promote a ballot proposition or question, candidate, or political party, directly or indirectly.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that any foreign government, foreign entity, noncitizen, or nongovernmental source that violates <u>proposed law</u> shall be fined not more than twice the amount of the donation, imprisoned for not more than five years with or without hard labor, or both.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that any person that accepts a donation in violation of <u>proposed law</u> and that has actual knowledge that the donation violates <u>proposed law</u> shall return the donation.

Proposed law defines "directly or indirectly" and "foreign entity".

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on House and Governmental</u> <u>Affairs</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

- 1. Impose criminal penalties on the foreign government, foreign entity, noncitizen, or nongovernmental source that makes a prohibited donation, rather than the recipient of the donation.
- 2. Require the person that receives a donation in violation of <u>proposed law</u> to return the donation if the person has actual knowledge that the donation violates <u>proposed law</u>.
