Provides for training of elected officials and employees of certain local governmental entities relative to public contracts. (gov sig)

Proposed law requires elected officials and employees of a municipality whose job duties include the managing, tracking, or compliance of a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement to participate in public-private contract payment training related to public contracts and payments, payment timing, interest, costs to private entities incurred outside of the scope of the project, change orders to the project, and the timing of change orders. Proposed law provides that the training may be provided by a state agency or an association or group and may be web-based.
