10	area of law may not include the legislative process; and
11	WHEREAS, licensed attorneys are in a unique position to assist Louisiana citizens
12	in obtaining a general understanding of the legislative process.
13	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
14	urge and request the Supreme Court of Louisiana to require attorneys to complete a one-hour
15	course on the legislative process.
