Appropriates supplemental funding and provides for means of finance substitutions and other budgetary adjustments for Fiscal Year 2024-2025. Provides for net increases (decreases) as follows: State General Fund (Direct) by \$146,985,067; Interagency Transfers by \$28,066,622; Fees and Self-generated Revenues by (\$60,704,150); Statutory Dedications by \$247,296,220; and Federal Funds by \$187,100,316.

Adopts a formula for distribution of the FY 2023-2024 surplus to the unfunded accrued liability of the retirement systems. Based on the formula, appropriates \$148,771,996 of State General Fund (Direct) of nonrecurring revenue out of the surplus from Fiscal Year 2023-2024 for unfunded accrued liability in the Louisiana State Police Retirement System.
