1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 3, delete lines 1 through 3 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

3 "(9) "Minor" means an individual under the age of eighteen and is not  
4 emancipated or married."

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 3, line 6, change "age" to "age, and is not emancipated or married,"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 5, line 6, after "age" insert "category"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 8, after line 29, add the following:

11 "(4) Require a covered application store provider or developer to obtain  
12 parental consent for an application that does any of the following:

13 (a) Provides direct access to emergency services, including:

14 (i) 911.

15 (ii) Crisis hotlines.

16 (iii) Emergency assistance services legally available to minors.

17 (b) Limits data collection to information necessary to provide emergency  
18 services in compliance with 15 U.S.C. 6501 et seq., Children's Online Privacy  
19 Protection Act.

20 (c) Provides access without requiring account creation or collection of  
21 unnecessary personal information.

22 (d) Is operated by or in partnership with any of the following:

23 (i) A government entity.

24 (ii) A nonprofit organization.

25 (iii) An authorized emergency service provider.

26 (5) Require a developer to collect, retain, reidentify, or link any information  
27 beyond any of the following:

28 (a) What is necessary to verify age categories and parental consent status as  
29 required by this Chapter.

30 (b) What is collected, retained, reidentified, or linked in the developer's  
31 ordinary course of business."
