2 On page 2, line 3, after "**R.S. 37:1262,**" delete "**who is**"

4 On page 2, at the beginning of line 10, after "**a**" and before "**law**" insert "**tactical**" and after  
5 "**enforcement**" change "**agency**" to "**unit**"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 2, line 15, after "**to a**" insert "**tactical**"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 2, at the beginning of line 16, change "**tactical team**" to "**unit**"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 5

11 On page 2, line 26, change "**law enforcement agency**" to "**tactical law enforcement unit**"

13 On page 2, line 28, after "**himself**" delete "**or herself**"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 7

15 On page 3, at the end of line 2, after "**enforcement**" add "**unit**"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 8

17 On page 3, line 3, after "**his**" delete "**or her**"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 9

19 On page 3, line 19, after "requirements" change "must" to "**shall**"

20 AMENDMENT NO. 10

21 On page 3, line 23, after "**for**" change "**reserve and auxiliary peace**" to "**auxiliary**"

22 AMENDMENT NO. 11

23 On page 3, at the beginning of line 25. after "**A.**" insert "**(1)**" and change "**a reserve of**  
24 **auxiliary peace**" to "**an auxiliary**"

25 AMENDMENT NO. 12

26 On page 3, line 27, after "**council.**" delete the remainder of the line, delete line 28, and insert  
27 the following:

28 **"The maximum number of hours required for auxiliary officer training under**  
29 **this Section shall not exceed one hundred twenty hours. The auxiliary officer**  
30 **shall pass an examination approved by the council within one calendar year of**  
31 **initial service with a law enforcement agency.**

1           **(2) This curriculum shall be created by the council with courses**  
2 **including but not limited to legal definitions, stop and frisk, Miranda rights,**  
3 **arrests, elements of probable cause determinations, firearm training, officer**  
4 **survival skills, de-escalation strategies, use of force, cardiopulmonary**  
5 **resuscitation, and first aid. This curriculum may be taught at the auxiliary**  
6 **officer's affiliated law enforcement agency by a P.O.S.T. certified trainer.**

7           **(3) For the purpose of this Chapter, "auxiliary officer" means an**  
8 **individual who has volunteered his service to a law enforcement agency to assist**  
9 **in preserving public safety and has been certified as an auxiliary officer by the**  
10 **council. An auxiliary officer shall serve under the supervision of a P.O.S.T.**  
11 **certified peace officer.**

12           **(4) The responsibilities of an auxiliary officer may include duties such as**  
13 **event security and traffic direction, including but not limited to, funeral**  
14 **processions, athletic contests and sporting events, parades, festivals, or other**  
15 **similar activities, as supplemental or additional personnel. An auxiliary officer**  
16 **may not effect an arrest, issue citations, or conduct searches and seizures unless**  
17 **he is under the direct supervision of a P.O.S.T. certified peace officer."**
