Abstract: Requires the La. Dept. of Health to establish and collect an annual fee from a retail permit holder authorized to sell therapeutic marijuana.

<u>Present law</u> requires the annual renewal of a retail permit to sell recommended marijuana for therapeutic use. <u>Present law</u> requires the proper application and payment of fees as required by the La. Dept. of Health (LDH).

<u>Proposed law</u> requires LDH to establish and collect an annual fee of \$22,500 from each retail permit holder authorized to sell recommended therapeutic marijuana.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the La. Dept. of Health shall collect information from a licensee authorized to produce therapeutic marijuana about the amounts paid each year to the licensee related to the licensee's production of therapeutic marijuana.

Proposed law repeals present law.
