1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete line 2 in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

3 "To amend and reenact R.S. 40:1203.3(A)(introductory paragraph), (1), and (3) and  
4 (B) and to enact R.S. 40:1203.3(F), relative to"

6 On page 1, delete line 7 in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

7 "Section 1. R.S. 40:1203.3(A)(introductory paragraph), (1), and (3) and (B) is  
8 hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 40:1203.3(F) is hereby enacted to read as follows:"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 3

10 On page 1, delete lines 8 through 10 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

11 "§1203.3. Refusal to hire or contract; termination of employment; exceptions to  
12 hiring prohibition; appeal procedure; waiver

13 A. Except as otherwise provided in R.S. 40:1203.2(C) and ~~Subsection~~ Subsections  
14 E and F of this Section, no employer shall hire any licensed ambulance personnel or  
15 nonlicensed person when the results of a criminal history check reveal that the licensed  
16 ambulance personnel or nonlicensed person has been convicted of any of the following  
17 offenses:

18 (1) R.S. 14:28.1, 30, 30.1, 31, 32.6, 32.7, 32.12, 34, ~~34.1~~, 34.7, 35.2, ~~37~~, 37.1, 37.4,  
19 38.1, 42, 42.1, 43, 43.1, 43.2, 43.3, 43.5, 44, 44.1, 46.2, ~~51~~, 60, 64, ~~64.1~~, 64.4, ~~66~~, ~~67.16~~, 89,  
20 89.1, 93.3, 93.4, 93.5, 283.3 or distribution or possession with the intent to distribute of  
21 controlled dangerous substances as listed in Schedules I through V of the Uniform  
22 Controlled Dangerous Substances Act.

24 (3) The felony offense involving theft, pursuant to R.S. 14:67(B)(1), or theft of  
25 assets of an aged person or person with a disability, pursuant to R.S. 14:67.21 in excess of  
26 five hundred dollars or in any case in which the offender has been previously convicted of  
27 theft, pursuant to R.S. 14:67, or theft of assets of an aged person or person with a disability,  
28 pursuant to R.S. 14:67.21, regardless of the value of the instant theft.
