Amendments proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to
Original House Bill No. 220 by Representative Willard

1 AMENDMENT NO. 12 On page 1, line 9, after "firearm" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 10 and 11
3 in their entirety and insert the following:4 "occurs when a person leaves a loaded firearm within a dwelling or vehicle, when
5 that person knows or reasonably should know that a minor child is likely to gain
6 access to the firearm without the lawful permission of the minor child's parent or the
7 person having charge of the minor child, and when the minor child obtains
8 possession of such firearm and then does either of the following."9 AMENDMENT NO. 2

10 On page 1, delete lines 13 and 14 in their entirety and insert the following:

11 "(2) Exhibits the firearm in a public place."12 AMENDMENT NO. 313 On page 2, line 2, after "obtains" and before "access" delete "supervised"14 AMENDMENT NO. 4

15 On page 2, between lines 3 and 4, insert the following:

16 "(3) When a person is carrying a firearm on his person.17 (4) When a person secures the firearm with a trigger lock or stores the
18 firearm in a securely locked box or container which a reasonable person would
19 believe to be secure."20 AMENDMENT NO. 5

21 On page 2, after line 7, add the following:

22 "E. No peace officer nor any other person shall arrest a person for a violation
23 of this Section before the seventh day following the date on which the offense is
24 alleged to have been committed if both of the following circumstances exist:25 (1) The offender is a member of the family of the child who discharged the
26 firearm.27 (2) The child has caused death or serious injury to himself through discharge
28 of the firearm."
