29 C.(1)D.(1) Revenue generated as a result of electronic enforcement devices
 30 in school zones shall be divided between the governing authority of the school where
 31 the traffic citation was issued and the municipality after the governing authority pays

- the contractor or vendor for the costs of providing the electronic enforcement devices and related services.
 - (2) A cooperative endeavor agreement executed by the municipality and each governing authority of the schools located within the municipality's boundaries shall be in place prior to <u>the</u> implementation of automated speed enforcement devices and mobile speed cameras.
- 7 (3) Revenue generated within Orleans Parish outside of a school zone shall
 8 only be used for the purposes of stormwater drainage infrastructure, maintenance,
 9 and improvements.
- 10 (4) Revenue generated as a result of electronic enforcement devices outside
 11 of a school zone shall only be used for public safety purposes.
 - D.(1)<u>E.(1)</u> Any jurisdiction that submits a local match waiver for capital outlay shall disclose the amount of revenue collected from handheld traffic cameras <u>electronic enforcement devices</u>. The failure to disclose the information required by this Subsection shall result in any local match waiver being revoked.
- 16 (2) No local match waiver shall be revoked pursuant to this Subsection for 17 any of the following types of capital outlay projects:
 - (a) Water system projects.
 - (b) Sewer system projects.
 - (c) Natural gas system projects."
