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SB 19 Engrossed 2025 Regular Session Fesi

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes a pharmacist to dispense ivermectin to a person 18 or older pursuant to a standing order issued by a healthcare professional in the La. Dept. of Health (LDH).

Proposed law requires LDH to adopt rules to establish procedures for dispensing ivermectin.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes a pharmacy to charge an administrative fee for any services required by <u>proposed law</u> in addition to the ingredient cost and dispensing fee.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for civil immunity for pharmacists dispensing ivermectin in accordance with <u>proposed law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a health insurance issuer is not required to provide coverage for the cost of ivermectin dispensed pursuant to <u>proposed law</u>.

Effective August 1, 2025.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Health and Welfare</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

1. Add that a pharmacist may dispense ivermectin to any person over the age of 18 pursuant to a standing order issued by a healthcare professional with prescriptive authority in the La. Dept. of Health.
