Amendments proposed by House Committee on Insurance to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 42 by Senator Selders

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 4, after "definitions;" and before "and" insert "to provide for applicability
relative to coverage plans;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 17, after "<u>attending physician</u>" insert a comma "<u>,</u>" and "<u>physician</u> 6 assistant, psychiatrist, psychologist, medical psychologist, or nurse practitioner"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 2, line 3, after "<u>coverage.</u>" and before "<u>Health</u>" insert the following:

9 "<u>The treating physician shall consider recognized evidenced based standards,</u> 10 <u>such as guidelines of InterQual or Milliman Care Guidelines (MCG), in making</u> 11 treatment recommendations."

12 AMENDMENT NO. 4

13 On page 2, between lines 8 and 9, insert the following:

14 "D. The coverage required pursuant to this Section may be subject to annual

15 <u>deductibles, coinsurance, and copayment provisions established under the health</u>

16 <u>benefit plan.</u>"

17 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 5</u>

- 18 On page 2, at the beginning of line 9, change "<u>**D**</u>." to "<u>**E**</u>."
- 19 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 6</u>
- 20 On page 3, after line 21, add the following:

"Section 3. The provisions of this Act apply to any new policy, contract, or health
coverage plan issued on and after January 1, 2026. Any policy, contract, or health coverage
plan in effect prior to January 1, 2026, shall convert to conform to the provisions of this Act

on or before the renewal date, but no later than January 1, 2027."
