2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:1801.1(C), relative to acts of criminal hazing; to provide
3	relative to requirements of certain students at postsecondary education institutions;
4	and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 17:1801.1(C) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§1801.1. Hazing education; policies; new student orientation; organizations
8	* * *
9	C. Each organization as defined in R.S. 17:1801 shall, as a condition of
10	operating at an institution, adopt the hazing prevention policy that the institution has
11	adopted pursuant to Subsection A of this Section, which shall include possible
12	institutional sanctions against the organization in the event of a reported or
13	confirmed hazing incident, and a policy that prohibits hazing. Each organization
14	shall provide annually at least one hour two hours of hazing prevention education
15	that includes education relative to such policies to all members, prospective
16	members, and anyone who is employed by or volunteers with the organization. The
17	education may be provided in person, electronically, or both. Each organization
18	shall submit a report annually to the institution with which it is affiliated relative to
19	the students, employees, and volunteers receiving such education evidenced by an

The institution shall2terminate the organization's operation on campus if it fails to comply with the3provisions of this Subsection and shall submit a report to the House Committee on4Education and Senate Committee on Education upon such termination.5Section 2. This Act may be cited and shall be known as the "Anti-Hazing Education:6Enough is Enough Act".
