CIVIL/LAW: Provides relative to the freedom to display the flag of the United States

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Includes size of the flag in enforcement of lease, covenant, or other contractual provisions of a planned community document, condominium association document, or individual lessor.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that no planned community, condominium association, or lessor shall adopt, or enforce any provision outlawing or restricting an individual from displaying a removable, portable U.S. flag.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that nothing in <u>proposed law</u> shall prevent a planned community, condominium association, or lessor from adopting or enforcing reasonable provisions as to the size, time, place, and manner of displaying the U.S. flag.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for injunctive relief, court costs, and reasonable attorney fees when a violation of <u>proposed law</u> occurs.
