COURTS: Provides relative to filings in civil and criminal courts

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Provides that all civil and criminal filings made by an attorney shall be filed either in person in paper form or electronically with the clerk of court.
2. Provides that an original testament may be submitted by certified mail or commercial courier for retention by the clerk of court as provided by present law.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law provides that all civil and criminal filings made by an attorney shall be filed electronically with the clerk of court.

Proposed law retains present law and provides that all civil and criminal filing made by an attorney shall be filed either in person in paper form or electronically with clerk of court.

Proposed law provides that an original testament may be submitted by certified mail or commercial courier for retention by the clerk of court as provided by C.C.P. Art. 2911.
