years being served without benefit of probation, parole, or suspension of sentence.
and one-half One-half of the fines collected pursuant to this Paragraph shall be
distributed in accordance with R.S. 15:539.4."

(3) Whoever commits the crime of soliciting for prostitutes when the person
 being solicited is under the age of fourteen years shall be fined not less than five
 thousand dollars nor more than seventy-five thousand dollars, imprisoned at hard
 labor for not less than twenty-five years nor more than fifty years, or both, with at
 least ten years being served without benefit of probation, parole, or suspension of
 sentence. and one-half One-half of the fines collected pursuant to this Paragraph
 shall be distributed in accordance with R.S. 15:539.4."

 at least five years being served without benefit of probation, parole, or suspension
 of sentence."

suspension of sentence."

43 or both, with at least ten years being served without benefit of probation, parole, or

(3) Whoever commits the crime of pandering involving the prostitution of persons under the age of fourteen years shall be fined not more than seventy-five thousand dollars, imprisoned at hard labor for not less than twenty-five years nor more than fifty years, or both, with at least ten years being served without benefit of probation, parole, or suspension of sentence."

(c) Whoever commits the crime of enticing persons into prostitution when the
 person being enticed into prostitution is under the age of fourteen years shall be fined
 not more than seventy-five thousand dollars, imprisoned at hard labor for not less
 than twenty-five years nor more than fifty years, or both, with at least ten years being
 served without benefit of probation, parole, or suspension of sentence."

be fined not more than seventy-five thousand dollars, imprisoned at hard labor for
not less than twenty-five years nor more than fifty years, or both, with at least ten
years being served without benefit of probation, parole, or suspension of sentence."
