10 Fiscal Affairs and adopted by the Senate on June 3, 2025, on page 1, line 11, after "(D)(1),"
11 delete "(2)(a) and (b),"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 4

13 In Senate Committee Amendment No. 9 proposed by the Senate Committee on Revenue and
14 Fiscal Affairs and adopted by the Senate on June 3, 2025, on page 2, line 27, change
15 "Section 3." to "Section 2."

16 AMENDMENT NO. 5

17 On page 1, line 4, after "program;" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 5 and
18 insert "to provide for targeted business sectors; to provide for reporting requirements; to
19 provide for an enhanced credit in certain situations; to provide for applicability; to provide
20 for an effective date; and to provide for related"

21 AMENDMENT NO. 6

22 On page 2, delete lines 10 through 22

23 AMENDMENT NO. 7

24 On page 3, line 2, after "investment" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 3 and
25 insert "with the credit divided in equal portions for two years."

26 AMENDMENT NO. 8

27 On page 3, delete lines 19 through 29 and on page 4, delete lines 1 through 22, and insert the
28 following:

29 "Section 3. The provisions of this Act shall apply to taxable periods beginning on
30 January 1, 2025.

31 Section 4. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
32 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
33 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
34 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
35 effective on the day following such approval."
