Approval by the legislature of a consent decree or settlement agreement 18 by concurrent resolution as provided in this Section shall be conducted in the same 19 manner and by the same procedure established for a suspension of a law pursuant to Article III, Section 20 of the Constitution of Louisiana, except that the fixed period 20 21 of suspension shall not apply. C. No elected official that is listed in this Section shall enter into a consent 22 23 decree or settlement agreement related to a redistricting or reapportionment map of 24 the legislature or that modifies any other district map or boundary."
