1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 30:2543, relative to the release of balloons outdoors; to prohibit the intentional
3	release of inflated balloons outdoors; to provide for a fine for releasing inflated
4	balloons; to provide for the fines to be directed into the litter abatement account
5	within the Conservation Fund; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 30:2543 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§2543. Intentional release of balloons prohibition; fines
9	A. No person over the age of sixteen or entity shall intentionally release,
10	coordinate the release, or otherwise cause the release of a balloon or group of
11	balloons inflated with a gas that is lighter than air, except for:
12	(1) A balloon released for scientific or meteorological purposes on behalf of
13	a governmental agency or pursuant to a governmental contract.
14	(2) A hot air balloon that is recovered after launching.
15	(3) A balloon that is released and remains indoors.
16	(4) A balloon equipped with radio tracking devices that is released for
17	educational purposes by an individual holding a valid amateur radio operator license.
18	B.(1) Any person or entity that violates this Section shall be subject to a civil
19	penalty of:
20	(a) One hundred fifty dollars for the first violation.
21	(b) Two hundred fifty dollars for the second violation.

1	(c) Five hundred dollars for the third or subsequent violation.
2	(2) For purposes of this Subsection, the release of multiple balloons at one
3	time shall be considered a single violation.
4	(3) Any fines collected pursuant to this Subsection shall be deposited into
5	the litter abatement account which is created within the Conservation Fund through
6	provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15).
