Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Provide for net increases (decreases) in appropriations as follows: \$67,942,433 in State General Fund (Direct); (\$26,271,531) in Interagency Transfers; \$165,695,088 in Fees and Self-generated Revenues; \$1,871,851,991 in Statutory Dedications; and \$1,259,964,446 in Federal Funds.
