1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 44:11.2(E)(1)(introductory paragraph) and (2)(c) and
3	(H)(introductory paragraph), to enact R.S. 44:11.2(A)(6), (7), (8), and (9) and (J),
4	and to repeal R.S. 44:11.2(D), relative to the personal information of protected
5	individuals; to provide for protection of the personal information of district
6	attorneys, assistant district attorneys, and district attorney investigators; to provide
7	for records of the office of the secretary of state; to provide for an effective date; and
8	to provide for related matters.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 44:11.2(E)(1)(introductory paragraph) and (2)(c) and
11	(H)(introductory paragraph) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 44:11.2(A)(6), (7),
12	(8), and (9) and (J) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
13	§11.2. Limited access to personal information for protected individuals
14	A. As used in this Section, the term "protected individual" shall mean:
15	* * *
16	(6) A current or retired district attorney, assistant district attorney, or district
17	attorney investigator.
18	(7) A current member of the legislature.
19	(8) A current statewide elected official.
20	(9) A current member of the public service commission.

22	E.(1) A protected individual, or the judicial administrator's office on behalf
23	of a protected individual identified in Paragraphs (A)(1) through (5) of this Section
24	or the Louisiana District Attorneys Association on behalf of a protected individual

21	Section 3. This Act shall become effective on February 1, 2026.
