ACT 407 (SB 36)

Prior law provided for the jurisdiction of the commissioner of conservation over the geologic sequestration of carbon dioxide.

New law changes commissioner to secretary. Further requires the secretary to give substantial consideration to local government comments when determining the appropriate course of action in any matter that requires a public comment period or hearing.

Existing law provides for issuance of certificates of public convenience and necessity and certificates of completion of injection operations, after public hearing and satisfaction of certain requirements.

New law provides that a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to a transporter of carbon dioxide prior to the effective date of new law, shall remain valid.

Effective June 20, 2025.
