<u>Existing law</u> requires wholesale and retail seafood dealers acquiring fish from commercial fisherman to complete a receipt recording certain information related to the transaction.

Prior law required the receipt be provided to the fisherman at the time of the transaction.

<u>New law</u> requires that the receipt be transmitted to the fisherman within 24 hours of the transaction.

<u>Existing law</u> provides that the dealer was responsible for information recorded on receipt, including dealer's name and license number, fisherman's name, license number and signature, transaction date, species, quantity and units of each species, size and condition of each species, unit price of each species, and permit number if required.

Prior law required the information be recorded at the time of the transaction.

<u>New law</u> provides that the dealer is responsible for the recorded information with 24 hours of the transaction.

Effective August 1, 2025.
