<u>Existing law</u> provides for the issuance and regulation of various high and low alcoholic beverage permits.

<u>New law</u> provides that beginning on Aug. 1, 2025, and ending on Dec. 31, 2026, no permits for the sale of high or low alcoholic beverages issued under <u>existing law</u> shall be granted within the boundaries of District 3 of the La. House of Representatives.

<u>New law</u> provides that the limitation on the issuance of permits shall apply only to Class B or Class C permits for licensed premises that contain less than 5,000 square feet of public habitable floor area.

<u>New law</u> provides that valid existing permits may continue and be renewed if the permit holder remains in compliance with all other provisions of law and local ordinances.

<u>New law</u> provides that if any such permit holder ceases to operate as a business or if any such permit holder fails to maintain a valid permit for any reason and for any period of time, the permit holder shall not be entitled to a new or renewal permit.

Effective August 1, 2025.
