Chassion

<u>Existing law</u> requires persons authorized to dispense or distribute controlled dangerous substances or drugs monitored by the Prescription Monitoring Program to submit certain information to the La. Board of Pharmacy (board).

<u>Existing law</u> requires the board to establish standards by rulemaking for the retention, archiving, and destruction of prescription monitoring information.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and further requires the board to establish rulemaking standards for the retention, archiving, and destruction of audit trail information.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and further states that <u>existing</u> and <u>new law</u> shall not be construed to modify the provisions of <u>existing law</u> (R.S. 44:411).

<u>New law</u> requires all agencies to keep all records in accordance with <u>existing law</u> after approval and requires approval before destroying records.

Effective August 1, 2025.
