Chassion

Existing law requires persons authorized to dispense or distribute controlled dangerous substances or drugs monitored by the Prescription Monitoring Program to submit certain information to the La. Board of Pharmacy (board).

Existing law requires the board to establish standards by rulemaking for the retention, archiving, and destruction of prescription monitoring information.

New law retains existing law and further requires the board to establish rulemaking standards for the retention, archiving, and destruction of audit trail information.

New law retains existing law and further states that existing and new law shall not be construed to modify the provisions of existing law (R.S. 44:411).

New law requires all agencies to keep all records in accordance with existing law after approval and requires approval before destroying records.

Effective August 1, 2025.
