AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 18:59.4(D)(1), relative to certification programs; to provide for training programs approved by the State Board of Election Supervisors; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. 18:59.4(D)(1) is hereby amended to read as follows:

§59.4. The Louisiana Voter Registration Administrators' Certification Program; requirements; compensation

* * *

D.(1) The requisite education and training will be provided through courses of the Certified Elections Registration Administrator program administered through Auburn University and the Election Center, a national certification designation, or a substantially equivalent program approved by the State Board of Election Supervisors. Any course taken by a registrar of voters, chief deputy registrar, or confidential assistant shall be a course that is required for the attainment of certification or maintenance of such certification.
