
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2026 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works
to Original House Bill No. 746 by Representative Owen

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 3, after "vehicles;" delete the remainder of the line and insert "to remove the
3 requirement that a vehicle obtain a special permit from an agency or department or political
4 subdivision other than the Department of Transportation and Development; to provide for
5 a one year moratorium on the issuance of any local permits for oversized vehicles;"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 On page 1, at the beginning of line 4, delete "oversized vehicles;"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, line 8, after "A." and before "No" delete "(1)"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, delete lines 17 and 18 in their entirety

12 AMENDMENT NO. 5

13 On page 1, after line 19, insert the following:

14 "Section 2. A moratorium is hereby established on the issuance of any local
15 permits for oversized vehicles for a period of one year from the effective date of this
16 Act. During this moratorium, no political subdivision shall adopt any new permit
17 requirements for oversized vehicles.

18 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor
19 or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law
20 without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the
21 Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by
22 the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval."
