Present law requires a transportation network company driver carry proof of coverage of insurance.

Present law requires a transportation network company driver to provide insurance coverage information, in the event of an accident, to directly interested parties, automobile insurers, and investigating officer only upon request. Proposed law requires the driver to provide insurance coverage information without the requirement of a request.

Present law requires a transportation network company driver to disclose upon request to directly interested parties, automobile insurers, and investigating officer whether the driver was logged on to the transportation network company's digital network or on a prearranged ride at the time of an accident. Proposed law requires the driver to provide this information without the requirement of a request.

Proposed law provides for penalties for failure to provide the required information.

Effective August 1, 2026.
