ETHICS/CODE: Authorizes legislators to accept complimentary reasonable transportation to foreign countries

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 42:1102(20)(b)(iv), relative to reasonable transportation; to provide for the  
3 acceptance of complimentary reasonable transportation by legislators; to provide for  
4 travel to a foreign country under certain circumstances; and to provide for related  
5 matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 42:1102(20)(b)(iv) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §1102. Definitions

9 Unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the following words and  
10 terms, when used in this Chapter, shall have the following meanings:

14 (b) "Reasonable transportation", with reference to legislators only, means

17 (iv) Organized primarily for trade, cultural, diplomatic, educational, or

19 foreign country or a civic, nonprofit, educational, or political organization. However,



Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs to the original bill:

1. Prohibit accepting transportation to a foreign country if sponsored by a foreign adversary.

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Make technical changes.
