Amendments proposed by Representative Terry Landry to Engrossed House Bill No. 722

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 5, after "fines;" and before "and" insert "to provide for a limitation;"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, delete lines 17 through 20 in their entirety and on page 2, delete lines 1 through
5 4 in their entirety and insert the following:

6 "(b)(i) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a person's
7 driver's license that has been suspended, cancelled, or revoked for nonpayment of
8 fees shall be automatically reinstated if both of the following occur:

9 (aa) The person makes full payment of all fees or fines assessed by the
10 Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, that resulted
11 in the suspension, cancellation, or revocation of the driver's license.

12 (bb) The person provides proof of payment of any fees or fines, as
13 contemplated by R.S. 32:393, or any other provision under this Title.

14 (ii) The provisions of this Subparagraph do not apply to a person whose
15 driver's license has been suspended, cancelled, or revoked for operating a vehicle
16 while impaired pursuant to R.S. 14:98."

17 AMENDMENT NO. 3

18 On page 2, delete lines 18 through 25 in their entirety and insert the following:

19 "(b)(i) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a person's
20 driver's license that has been suspended, cancelled, or revoked for nonpayment of
21 fees shall be automatically reinstated if both of the following occur:

22 (aa) The person makes full payment of all fees or fines assessed by the
23 Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, that resulted
24 in the suspension, cancellation, or revocation of the driver's license.

25 (bb) The person provides proof of payment of any fees or fines, as
26 contemplated by R.S. 32:393, or any other provision under this Title.

27 (ii) The provisions of this Subparagraph do not apply to a person whose
28 driver's license has been suspended, cancelled, or revoked for operating a vehicle
29 while impaired pursuant to R.S. 14:98."
