Creates the office of health and nutrition within the Louisiana Department of Health. (gov sig)

Proposed law adds the office of health and nutrition to the existing offices within LDH. The office is responsible for: (1) leading and coordinating the Governor’s Council on Physical Fitness and sports, the Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC), and the Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP), (2) developing and strengthening policy to increase access and consumption of healthy foods among members of the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), (3) leading and coordinating department initiatives that include addressing health and nutrition, health care access, preventative health care services, and chronic disease prevention and management programs, (4) coordinating with the Office of Adult and Aging Services and the Office of Public Health to provide public education. Proposed law provides that the Office of the Secretary and the Office of Health and Nutrition shall be under the direct supervision, direction, and control of the secretary of LDH, and provides for an executive director for the Office of Health and Nutrition that reports directly to the secretary. Proposed law authorizes LDH to transfer funding and positions within the department to establish and implement the office of health and nutrition. Proposed law becomes effective upon signature of the governor, or after the lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. Proposed law will have no impact on expenditures associated with the establishment of the Office of Health and Nutrition. This measure authorizes LDH to transfer funding and positions within the department to establish the new office.

According to information provided by LDH, funding and Table of Organization (T.O.) positions will be transferred from the Office of Public Health (OPH), the Office of the Secretary (OS), and Medical Vendor Administration (MVA) to create the Office of Health and Nutrition, resulting in an overall net-zero impact to the department’s budget. LDH did not provide a list of T.O. positions or funding amounts incorporated in its proposed transfer. If this information becomes available, the LFO will update this fiscal note to include the additional details.
