Amendments proposed by House Committee on Education to Original House Bill No. 392

1 AMENDMENT NO. 12 On page 1, line 5, after "requirements;" and before "and" insert "to require signage at schools
3 about the national suicide prevention hotline number and a state suicide prevention website;"4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, between lines 6 and 7, insert the following:

6 "Section 1. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Student Suicide
7 Prevention Awareness Act.""8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, at the beginning of line 7, change "Section 1." to "Section 2."

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, between lines 16 and 17, insert the following:

12 "(c) A link to Louisiana988.org, a suicide prevention initiative of the
13 Louisiana Department of Health."14 AMENDMENT NO. 5

15 On page 2, between lines 2 and 3, insert the following:

16 "(3)(a) Each middle school and high school that receives federal funds shall
17 post signage to inform students about the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline
18 hotline number, "988", with an explanation that this number may be called or texted.
19 The signage shall include a brief message encouraging students experiencing
20 emotional distress to seek help as well as an explanation that the hotline is free,
21 confidential, and available twenty-four hours a day and seven days a week.22 (b) The signage shall also include information about Louisiana988.org and
23 an explanation that additional information and resources, including the ability to chat
24 online, are available at this website.25 (c) The signage shall be placed in locations easily visible to students such as
26 school entrances and exits, student common areas, school counselor offices, school
27 nurse offices, near restrooms and locker rooms, and digital school bulletin boards if
28 available."
