Abstract: Provides for the creation of commemorative birth certificates, the appropriate fees, and the allocation of the fees.

Proposed law creates commemorative birth certificates which will bear the state seal and the governor's signature.

Proposed law provides that commemorative birth certificates will be suitable for display and have the same status as evidence as that of a certified copy of a birth certificate.

Proposed law creates fees for commemorative birth certificates and allocates the fees to the state registrar and the office on women's health and community health.
