HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 371

A RESOLUTION

To commemorate the commencement of the American Revolution and recognize America's founding documents.

WHEREAS, the commencement of the American Revolution in 1775 led to the liberation of the American colonies and people from British rule; and

WHEREAS, the American victory at Yorktown and the signing of the Treaty of Paris led to the creation of the United States of America and the founding documents of American liberty, justice, and freedom, the Declaration of Independence, the Constitution of the United States of America, including the Bill of Rights, and the Federalist Papers; and

WHEREAS, the constitution creates the framework of our government and establishes the separation of powers and system of checks and balances that protects America's freedoms and system of justice; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature of Louisiana has demonstrated its commitment to the education of Louisiana's people on these historical documents and events by enacting laws requiring their inclusion in the education of the state's students.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commemorate the commencement of the American Revolution and does hereby recognize the importance of America's founding documents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana encourages the people of Louisiana to study and acknowledge the significance of America's founding documents and remember and honor those who fought in, and gave aid and comfort to, the cause of the American Revolution.
