ACT 233 (SB 28)

2026 Regular Session

McMath

Existing law authorizes the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to provide for an associate educator program through which a governing authority of a public elementary or secondary school may authorize certain individuals with associate's degrees to serve as teachers.

Prior law required participants in the program to be at least 25 years of age.

New law changes the required age from 25 to 21.

Effective May 15, 2026.
