ACT 228 (SB 18)

Existing law provides that certain retirees may continue reemployment and thier retirement benefit shall continue, and they shall not be a member of the system. Further, the retirement benefit of any retiree whose monthly earnings exceed the difference between the monthly average final compensation and the monthly allowance shall be reduced, and that retiree shall not be a member of the system.

Prior law provided an exception allowing retirees of the Municipal Employees' Retirement System of Louisiana (MERS) age 60 with 30 years of creditable service to return to employment without a benefit reduction. New law repeals prior law.

Prior law further provided for a benefit reduction applicable to reemployed retirees age 60 with 30 years of creditable service whose monthly earning exceeded the difference between his monthly average final compensation and his monthly retirement benefit. New law repeals prior law.

Effective August 1, 2026.
