ACT 179 (HB 845)

Bayham

Prior law required a person convicted of or forfeited bond on or plead guilty or nolo contendere to the charge of operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of beverages of high or low alcoholic content, of narcotic drugs, or of central nervous system stimulants to pay a drivers license reinstatement fee of \$100 for a first offense, \$200 for a second offense, and \$300 for any subsequent offense.

New law increases the reinstatement fee for a first offense from \$100 to \$200, for a second offense from \$200 to \$400, and for any subsequent offense from \$300 to \$600.

Effective August 1, 2026.
