Existing law provides policies for testing and inspecting all seafood sold in the state.

New law requires any retailer who purchases seafood to retain the purchase records for six months and to make them available to the department for inspection.

New law provides for a violation subject to civil penalties for failing to retain records or knowingly providing false or fraudulent purchase records.

Effective August 1, 2026.
