Existing law authorizes the commission to impose civil penalties, probation, and suspend or revoke permits, licenses, and registrations based on an adjudicatory hearing conducted in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act (APA).

Prior law required the commission to provide the alleged violator with at least 30 days notice of an adjudicatory hearing by certified mail.

New law requires a hearing notice be provided in accordance with the APA instead of requiring a minimum 30-day notice period.
