Bayham

Establishes the Louisiana-United Kingdom Trade Commission.

Provides for a 15-member commission appointed as follows:

- (1) Two members representing the energy industry, one appointed by the president of the Senate and one appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives.
- (2) Two members of the Senate, appointed by the president of the Senate.
- (3) Two members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives.
- (4) The commissioner of agriculture.
- (5) The commissioner of insurance.
- (6) Six members appointed by the governor; which members appointed shall include at least one representative from a public institution of higher education, at least one representative from Louisiana Economic Development, and at least one member of the public representing British-American communities or interests.
- (7) The secretary of state or a designee of the secretary of state.

Provides that the commission shall terminate on the date of the submission of its report or October 1, 2027, whichever occurs first.
